COURSE DESCRIPTION

Participants will be given an overview of systematic searching in PubMed and managing references in Zotero.

The course curriculum will be modular in form which likely to include the following session:

- ❖ Introduction to PubMed (The Four Principal of Searching)
- ❖ MeSH Data Base, MeSH Searching and Narrowing and focusing Search
- ❖ NCBI account, saving search strategy and Advance PubMed Search Building Strategy
- ❖ Creating and Managing Zotero Library
- ❖ Citing references and creating Bibliography
- ❖ Editing citation style to create new style

Every session will consist of a presentation and demonstration by the facilitator followed by ‘exercise tasks’ as an opportunity for the participants to practice. This will be followed by discussion and clarifying any queries in the group.

Mentors will be allocated to the participants for guiding them during and after the course.
