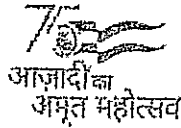

Dear Secretary,

Please recall the discussions during interaction of Hon'ble Prime Minister with Secretaries to the Government of India on 18th September, 2021.

2. The Prime Minister, inter-alia, emphasized the following:

- Every effort needs to be made to fully leverage the power of technology. All schemes/programmes of Government of India should therefore have an inbuilt digital component.
- In today's digital age, data is a very valuable resource. A single data source can be useful for multiple benefits. ~~Data governance is a key to our efforts to transform the lives of our countrymen. We must embrace the concept of "Data as wealth" and utilize this potential of data.~~
- Implementation of budget announcements needs to be taken forward in right earnest. Capital expenditure needs to be speeded up to meet the target for the current financial year. The progress in many Ministries at the end of the first quarter of financial year is not satisfactory.

Actionable points from PM's Independence Day Speech, 2021 may be identified by all Ministries/ Departments and time bound implementation ensured. In particular, a road map may be prepared for achieving 100% saturation under all Central Government schemes. In this regard, it may also be mentioned that this Secretariat has uploaded major initiatives announced in PM's Independence Day Speech on the e-Samiksha portal. All Ministries/ Departments are requested to report progress of implementation regularly on the said portal

The Government has established Capacity Building Commission (CBC) to reorient training of Civil Servants in line with evolving requirements. Ministries/Departments should reach out to the CBC and apprise them about their current training architecture/institutes and discuss in details their training needs, as also the need for continuation/reorientation of the extant training institutions. A nodal officer may be designated by each Ministry/Department for interaction with CBC.

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- GeM Portal has enormous potential as an e-market place. All Ministries/Departments and the organizations under them need to use this portal for all their procurements.
 - Secretaries may organize interaction sessions with their staff and seek their inputs/ suggestions relating to the work of their Ministry/Department.
2. Needless to say, I expect you to initiate immediate action on the above directions of the Prime Minister.
