NOTIFICATION

As recommended by the NEIGRIHMS College Council, the MBBS students of **5th Semester (2018 Batch)** are hereby notified to return to the Institute and report their presence between 19th to 21st November, 2020. It is advisable for the students to have the report of RTPCR testing for COVID-19 before coming to NEIGRIHMS, Shillong.

Students will have to undergo Institute quarantine for those not having the RT-PCR/CBNAAT/TruNat Negative report for COVID-19 within 72 hours (from date of sample collection to date of arrival), RTPCR test will be done at NEIGRIHMS and will be quarantine until the RT-PCR report is available. Students on quarantine will have to pay for the food during quarantine period. If somebody does not want to avail NEIGRIHMS institutional quarantine facility, they may make their own arrangement with intimation to the Dean, NEIGRIHMS, and the Institute will not be responsible for their wellbeing in the facility where they put up.

Protocol to be followed by students

1. Students need to inform in advance the tentative date and time of arrival to the NEIGRIHMS Quarantine Center, Nodal Person (Prof. A. J.Patowary- 7002063345 /Dr. Biswajeet Saikia - 9401059365) for necessary facility. E-mail to be sent to the Office of the Dean at <deanofficeneigrihms@gmail.com> in this issue
2. For those students who will require quarantine, they will be cleared by NEIGRIHMS Covid-19 Nodal Officer, Dr. Vijay Nongpiur and Team after RT-PCR report is available. The concern student will contact their respective Hostel Warden for entering into the MBBS Hostel.
3. Students are directed to maintain Social Distancing, Wearing Mask and Hand Hygiene.
4. Aarogya Setu App is to be downloaded and updated by the students.
5. Students are to follow the State Protocol, Govt. of Meghalaya, Health & Family Welfare Department, indicated in the Notification Health.No.94/2020/100, Dated 27th October 2020 in this issue.
