NOTIFICATION

The Final Year B.Sc. (Nursing) students who are to appear for the Final University Examination 2020 and those who will be appearing in the University Examination (Supplementary) 2020 are hereby notified to report back to the College by 27th and 28th October 2020 positively.

Students will have to undergo Institute quarantine for a period of 7 (seven) days after arrival at NEIGRIHMS. If somebody does not want to avail NEIGRIHMS institutional quarantine facility, they may make their own arrangement with intimation to the Principal, College of Nursing, NEIGRIHMS and the Institute will not be responsible for their well being in the facility where they are put up. Students will have to pay the Mess fees as admissible.

Students from within Meghalaya will have to undergo RTPCR test for COVID-19 on arrival.

Protocol to be followed by students :


1. Students will have to bring a recent (within 72 hours) negative RTPCR report upon arrival in NEIGRIHMS, Shillong.
2. On arrival, students are to report directly to the Warden on duty before entering the Hostel.
3. Students will be immediately in quarantine for a period of 7 (seven) days under supervision of the Warden on duty.
4. Repeat RTPCR test will be done in consultation with the Nodal Officer for COVID-19, NEIGRIHMS or if they develop any symptoms (fever, sore throat, breathlessness).
 - (a). If negative they will be released at the end of the quarantine period after assessment by the Nodal Officer for COVID-19, NEIGRIHMS.
 - (b). And if positive they will then be managed accordingly as per treatment protocol.
5. Students are directed to maintain social distance, wear mask and hand hygiene.
6. Aarogya Setu App is to be downloaded by the students.
7. Students are to follow the State Protocol, Govt. of Meghalaya in this issue.

8. Students need to inform in advance the tentative date and time of their arrival so that quarantine facility will be ready to any of the Wardens, College of Nursing, NEIGRIHMS whose number is given below :-
