**WALK IN INTERVIEW FOR RECRUITMENT OF SENIOR RESIDENT DOCTORS &
JUNIOR RESIDENT DOCTORS**

Walk in interview will be held on Wednesday the 20.10.2010 for the posts of Senior Resident doctor (three years) tenure & Junior Resident Doctor (One year) tenure from 11:00 am onwards in the Administrative Block, NEIGRIHMS, Permanent Campus, Mawdiangdiang, Shillong - 18

SENIOR RESIDENT DOCTOR for the following departments and the number of posts as mentioned against each:

(i). Anaesthesiology - 1 OBC (ii). Anatomy - 1 UR (iii). Biochemistry - 1 SC (iv). CTVS - 2 (1UR, 1OBC) (v). General Medicine - 2 (1SC, 1OBC) (vi). General Surgery - 1 UR (vii). Hospital Administration - 1 UR (viii). * Nephrology - 1UR (ix) O & G - 2 OBC (x) Paediatrics - 3 (2 OBC, 1 SC) (xi) Pathology - 1OBC (xii). * Psychiatry - 1UR (xiii) Radiodiagnosis - 1 OBC (xiv). Urology - 2 (1UR, 1OBC).

* The post of SRD, Psychiatry and SRD, Nephrology will be attached with the department of General Medicine.

A. Essential qualifications:

- I. Postgraduate degree or diploma in respective subject recognized by MCI after obtaining a medical qualification included in the Schedule - I & II of the 3rd Schedule of Indian Medical Council Act 1956 (persons possessing qualifications included in the part - II of the 3rd schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in section 13 (B) of the Act.
- II. Satisfactory completion of the compulsory internship/housemanship in a recognized hospital.
- III. * Candidate must be registered with the State Medical Council / Medical Council of India.

B. Desirable: Candidates having experience in the respective discipline / subject will be preferred.

Scale of Pay: Rs.18,750 + GP - Rs.6600 + NPA plus other allowances as admissible under the Central Govt. Rules in identical posts.

Age limit - 33 years

JUNIOR RESIDENT DOCTOR: 46 (18 UR, 16 OBC, 11 SC & 1 ST) for the various departments:

Vacancy may increase or decrease. The numbers of vacant posts indicated above are provisional and subject to the change according to vacancies without any notice.

A. Educational qualification required for the posts of JRDs:

- (i) Medical qualification included in the Schedule - I & II of the 3rd Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956 (persons possessing qualifications included in the part - II of the 3rd schedule should also fulfil the conditions specified in section 13 (B) of the Act.
- (ii) Satisfactory completion of the compulsory internship.

(iii) Candidate must be registered with the Central/State Medical Council.

Scale of Pay: Rs.15,600 + GP – Rs.5,400 + NPA plus other allowances as admissible under rules.

Age limit - 30 years

Eligible candidates are requested to present themselves for registration at 9:00 a.m to 10:30 a.m on - 20.10.2010 in the Administrative Block. They will have to fill in their particulars in the prescribed application format and enclosed all relevant documents duly attested viz DOB (10th certificate) /MBBS/MD/MS/Diploma, MCI Registration & Caste certificate if any.

Candidates are also instructed to bring all original documents for verification.

General Information:

1. Reservation for the above posts and age relaxation will be provided as per Govt.of India Norms.
2. If employed under the State or Central Govt or PSU/Autonomous body, applicants are required to produce NOC from competent authority, failing which they will not be allowed to appear for interview under any circumstances.
3. Canvassing in any form will disqualify candidate.
4. Crucial date for determination of eligibility with regards to age, educational qualification and experience etc. will be the date, the candidates appear in the interview.
5. Candidates who does not fulfil any one of the above conditions, will not be allowed to appear in the interview.
6. Candidates who have been sponsored by the Govt.of Meghalaya for MBBS/MD/MS programme are required to produce NOC from the Govt.of Meghalaya, failing which they will not be allowed to appear for interviews under any circumstances.
