## **General Information:**

- 3. Reservation for STs/SCs/OBCs and EWSs will be as per Govt. of India norms.
- 4. Persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rupees eight lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Reservation under Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) can be availed upon production of Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority (Annexure-I). The Income and Asset Certificate issued by any one of the following competent authorities in the prescribed format shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:-
  - (i) District Magistrate/Addl. District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Addl. Deputy Commissioner/1<sup>st</sup> Class Stipendary Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate /Extra Assistant Commissioner.
  - (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate.
  - (iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and
  - (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.
- 5. Persons working under Central/State Government/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous organization should submit their applications through proper channel. They may, however, send an advance copy of the application along with enclosures which should reach before the prescribed last date.
- 6. Candidates applying against post reserved for OBC category must submit a valid (up-to-date) "Non Creamy Layer" certificate from the appropriate authority.
- 7. The decision of the Institute as to eligibility or otherwise of a candidate will be final.
- 8. The applicants, who do not have requisite qualifications up to the last date for submission of applications, will not be considered.
