

- 9. 20KVA Centralized Power backup with desired capacity with N+1 to be provided to power de vices in entire hospital and A & B type quarter. Cable from each UPS to be laid to each rack. For ot her locations, 6KVA UPS at strategic locations.
- 10. List of camera locations will be provided from NEIGRIHMS
- 11. The vendor shall provide training on operation, Maintenance & Troubleshooting aspects of the offered CCTV camera system to NEIGRIHMS, Shillong during commissioning as well as after final handover of the system for uses. Bidder shall consider the same and quote accordingly.
- 12. The bidder shall arrange for all kinds of tools, tackles, testing instruments etc. as required during all operations for completion of work as per the scope of work.
- 13. The bidder shall arrange for all kinds of cable laying, fixing and positioning of networking rac ks with standard dressing, fixing and positioning of cameras, UPS power connectivity at all rack en ds.
- 14. The total length/quantity for supply of the cable will be considered on actual.
- 15. The cables should be laid overhead for outdoor locations using stay wire and GI poles.
- 16. Any other activity / job which may not be specifically mentioned in the scope of work, but req uired for successful completion of the work shall be part of the bidder's scope without any extra co st to NEIGRIHMS, Shillong.
- 17. It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder that all necessary safety measures and precautions are invariably ensured during execution of work and NEIGRIHMS, Shillong shall not be responsible for any injuries / accidents suffered by contract labour.
- 18. Dedicated / Toll free Telephone No. for service support: Bidder/OEM must have dedicated/Toll free Telephone for service support.
- 19. Escalation matrix for service support: Bidder and OEM must provide escalation matrix of Tele phone no. for service support.

# B. **Cabling and Marking Works**:

- 1. For indoor laying of UTP & power cables, MS Conduit to be used.
- 2. For outdoor laying of cables, Poles and stay wires or equivalent to be used.
- 3. Cable dressing inside the control room should be proper with marking and neatly routed so t hat minimum space is required for the cables, and it also looks aesthetically good.
- 4. All the cables shall have proper marking at both ends mentioning the camera/equipment number/name it is connected to at the other end, for easy identification and maintenance.
- 5. 42U Racks to be installed in Server Room for hosting NVRs, Switches, LIUs and other items.
- 6. 12U racks for indoor purpose & hospital area only. 6U indoor racks for colleges, hostel & quarters. 6U outdoor racks for outdoor pole mount purpose only.

- **C. Documents:** The bidder has to give full documentation of the setup which includes the foll owing:
- 1. VMS Programming Manuals.
- 2. User and technical manuals for other bought out items like power systems etc.
- 3. Architectural layout.
- 4. Detailed Connectivity Diagram.
- 5. Positioning and marking of all kinds of CCTV items.
- 6. List of IP addresses of VMS and Cameras.
- 7. User ids and passwords for all kind of active devices.
- 8. Soft copy of all the above documentation shall also be provided in addition to hard copy.
- 9. Warranty Documents.
- 10. Toll free Number for service support.
- 11. Escalation Matrix for service support.

### D. Maintenance and Support Services:

- 1. The maintenance contract period for supplied facility under this package shall be Seven (7) y ears commencing from Operational Acceptance. Out of which, three (03) years shall be defect liability period (DLP)/warranty from the date of taking over/operational acceptance and four (04) years Comprehensive AMC thereafter.
- 2. The warranty shall cover replacement of defective parts, modules and free software upgrade s. In case of delay beyond 7 days for replacement/repair, if any, warranty period will be extended accordingly.
- 3. The support will be provided on 8 x 6 on working days. For all third-party equipment (Hardwa re & Software), Bidder shall have back-to-back support along with supply of spare with appropriate response time from OEM/OEM Authorized representatives. Certificates/Agreement of such support shall be shared with NEIGRIHMS, Shillong along with other documents mentioned above.
- 4. Bidder shall be responsible for coordination with the OEM for all matter related to the equipm ent. But the Bidder shall be responsible for meeting the overall response times and availability req uirements specified in the Specification. Bidder shall be responsible for providing all support including but not limited to administration support, reinstallation/ configuration/reconfiguration, technical assistance, troubleshooting, answering technical/operational queries, future integration/upgradation support etc. during the 7 years of maintenance contract period.
- 5. Bidder to have ERP for management of tickets.
- 6. All the spares required for maintenance shall be maintained and provided by the vendor. Sta ndby of equal or higher configuration will be provided by the vendor on breakdown of equipment d uring DLP (Defect Liability period) / warranty and Comprehensive AMC period till it gets replaced/r epaired.
- 7. Take Backup of the system / configurations at regular interval as per policy/requirement.
- 8. MIS report to be submitted on monthly basis to NEIGRIHMS, Shillong.
- 9. Installation of security patches, updates as and when available or as informed by NEIGRIHM S, Shillong. Configuration of supplied software and hardware to manage/close vulnerabilities as an d when required.
- 10. The maintenance of the System shall be comprehensive and shall comprise of the following c ategory of works which is further elaborated for each of the different subsystems:
- a. Preventive and Breakdown Maintenance Activity (performance monitoring, system backup, p

atch management, updates, urgent issues and troubleshooting) as detailed below.

- b. Maintaining a minimum no. of specified spares. It must include 10 nos. of bullet and dome ca meras, four (04) 24 port PoE and 8 port PoE switch. Should give declaration of the same upon bid award on bidder's letterhead.
- Integration with new/existing equipment/system as per NEIGRIHMS, Shillong requirement.

#### **E.** Special condition of contracts:

- 1. All the technical specifications have to be complied to fully, (any part, compliance or conditio nal compliance will result in rejection of the offer); documentary evidence of these specification fr om OEM, technical manual and /or database should be submitted to NEIGRIHMS, Shillong.
- 2. All the types of supply of hardware, if some model of the offer equipment is rendered obsole te/ end of life by the successful bidder/ respective OEM higher version of model (of same make) is to be offered by the bidder with the consent of NEIGRIHMS, Shillong without any upward price implications.
- 3. The bidder is advised to examine site conditions and existing systems where the above-men tioned works are to be executed before quoting. Any clarification regarding nature work can be dis cussed with the office of In Charge, NEIGRIHMS, Shillong. No deviation/change in tender schedule and nature of work will be accepted after the tender is opened.
- 4. One high skilled project engineer/supervisor for project management to be provided during e xecution as per the below qualification:
- a. Graduate + Technical Certified from VMS or Surveillance OEM.
- 5. After commissioning of the project one high skilled, one semi skilled manpower to be provide d for the period of Seven years. The Salary has to be as per Central Wages Act. With PF & ESI/Medi claim Benefits. The deputed Engineer has to be certified from the OEM for both Camera, VMS & Pa ssive Equipment's.

- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.

- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.

# **Additional Clause For Comprehensive Maintenance Charges**

1.CMC shall include preventive maintenance including calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares, after satisfactory completion of Warranty. During the CMC period commencing from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturer's technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months or as per user requirement. Cost of consumables shall not be included in CMC.Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during CMC period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend CMC period by double the downtime period.

2.CMC charges to be indicated as percentage of cost of equipment quoted for each year after the warranty period.

3.GST shall be included in the CMC Charges guoted.

4.Cost of CMC will be added for Ranking/Evaluation purpose with depreciation formula. A 10% discounting rate per year shall be applied on CMC Charges for price evaluation on Net Present Value.

5. The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user.

6.While creating a bid or RA, buyers shall indicate whether CMC is required against Yes/No" options. If CMC Charges are included, an option for number of years for CMC required after the warranty period shall be available. Under this option up to 10 years can be chosen for CMC charges beyond warranty period.

7.In case the bid has a provision for CMC, the warranty of the product will also be deemed to have been converted into Comprehensive warranty including preventive maintenance and calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares, during the Warranty Period also. Sellers are therefore advised to include the cost of Comprehensive Warranty including spares (excluding consumables) also in product Cost.

8.The CMC functionality shall be available in bid only and no direct RA shall be applicable.In case of bid to R/A decrement rules shall be applicable on total price inclusive of CMC charges. Bunching of products shall not be available while creating bids with CMC charges.

8.1.Buyer shall indicate number of years of warranty by selecting different options available in the field depending on warranty parameter applicable in category parameters for the equipment. 8.2. The calculation of CMC Charges shall take into account the number of years of warranty and duration of CMC as specified while creating bid.

8.3.In the price evaluation, the system shall provide function to calculate the cost of each equipment by formula indicated below includingCMC and then show the inter-se-ranking of the bidders. The following are the variables

- (i) Number of years for which CMC required.
- (ii) Number of years of product warranty

8.4.CMC charges offered for each subsequent year should be same or higher than preceding year.

8.5.The CMC charges shall be offered within range of 3 to 25% of cost of equipment.

9. Since CMC charges are to be paid only later for each year during CMC period, applicable performance guarantee amount after placement of contract shall be based on the cost of equipment excluding the cost of CMC Charges.

10.Performance bank guarantee applicable for CMC is to be submitted at start of the CMC and shall be applicable between 2.5% to 10% as specified in bid on total CMC Charges. The PBG submitted after award of contract shall be released only after new PBG for the CMC period is submitted and accepted by buyer/consignee after due verification. Bank guarantee for CMC is to remain valid till completion of CMC period plus one year. The bank guarantee for CMC shall be submitted to buyer directly. In case, seller fails to submit the PBG or does not provide services for the CMC contract after expiry of warranty period then PBG of equipment shall be forfeited.

11.In case of splitting of order quantity, equipment cost and CMC charges offered by L1 bidder shall be matched by higher quoting eligible bidders on one-to-one basis. The equipment cost and CMC charges (year to year) shall be matched individually.

12. The CMC Contract shall be an offline contract to be handled by buyer. The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user and scope of CMC will be as per para 1 above.

13.CMC Charges are inclusive of all the charges for Transportation, Lodging, Boarding, all insurances including third party insurance and all other incidental charges. The same shall include GST. The prices also include cost of spares and damaged parts. Purchaser does not have any liability, whatsoever, over and above the cost of CMC. It also includes for arranging hand tools & tackles, special tools etc. required to carry out the work.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
