NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pactwitnesses as under;

1. Commitments of NEIGRIHMS:-

NEIGRIHMS undertakes that no official of NEIGRIHMS, connected directly or indirectly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or accept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favour or any material or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the BIDDER, either forthemselves or for any person, organisation or third party related to the contract in exchange for an advantage in the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting or implementation process related to the contract.

NEIGRIHMS will, during the pre-contract stage, treat all BIDDER alike, and will provide to all BIDDER thesame information and will not provide any such information to any particular BIDDER which could afford anadvantage tothatparticularBIDDERincomparison tootherBIDDER/TENDERER.

AlltheofficialsofNEIGRIHMSwillreporttotheappropriateGovernmentofficeanyatt emptedorcompletedbreachesoftheabovecommitmentsas wellasany substantialsuspicionofsuchabreach.

2. In case any such preceding misconduct on the part of such official(s) is rep orted by the BIDDER toNEIGRIHMS with full and verifiable facts and the same is prima facie found to be correct by NEIGRIHMS,necessary disciplinary proce edings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings may beinitiated by NEIGRIHMS and such a person shall be debarred from further d ealings related to the contractprocess. In such a case while an enquiry is bein g conducted by NEIGRIHMS the proceedings under the contractwould notbe st alled.

3. CommitmentsofBIDDER:-

The BIDDER commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means andillegal activities during any stage of its bid or during any pre-contract or post-contract stage in order to securethe contractorinf urtherance to secureitandin particular commitits elfto the following:

The Bidder will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, gift, co nsideration, reward, favour, any material or immaterial benefit or other advant age, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to anyofficial of NEIGRIHMS, connected directly or indirectly with the bidding process, or to any person, or

ganizationor third party related to the contract in exchange for any advantage in the bidding, evaluation, contracting and implementation of the Contract.

The BIDDER further undertakes that it has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly anybribe, gift, consideration, reward, favour, any mat erial or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to anyofficial of NEIGRIHMS or otherwise in procuring the Contract orforbearing to do or having done any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the contract or any othercontract with the Government for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the contractor ranyothercontract with the Government.

BIDDER shall disclose the name and address of agents and representatives and Indian BIDDER shalldisclosetheirforeign principalsorassociates.

BIDDER shall disclose the payments to be made by them to agents/ brokers or any other intermediary, inconnection withthisbid/contract.

The BIDDER further confirms and declares to NEIGRIHMS that the BIDDER is the original manufacturer /integrator/ authorized government sponsored export entity of the stores and has not engaged any individual orfirm or company whether Indian or foreign to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to NEIGRIHMSor any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially to the award of the contract to the BIDDER, nor hasany amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual, firm or company in respect of any such intercession, facilitation orrecommendation.

The BIDDER, either while presenting the bid or during pre-contract negotiations or before signing thecontract, shalldiscloseanypayments hehas made, is committed toor intends to maketoofficials of NEIGRIHMS or their family members, agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the econtractandthe details of services agreed upon for such payments.

The BIDDER will not collude with other parties interested in the contract to im pair the transparency, fairness and progress of the bidding process, bidevaluation, contracting and implementation of the contract.

The BIDDER will not accept any advantage in exchange for any corrupt practice, unfair means and illegalactivities.

The BIDDER shall not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information provided by NEIGRIHMS as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained in any electronic data carrier. The BIDD ERalsoundertakestoexercise due and adequate carelestany such information is divulged.

The BIDDER commits to refrain from giving any complaint directly or through any other manner withoutsupportingitwithfullandverifiablefacts.

The BIDDER shall not instigate or cause to instigate any third person to commit any of the actionsmentioned above.

If the BIDDER or any employee of the BIDDER or any person acting on be half of the BIDDER, eitherdirectly or indirectly, is a relative of any of the offi cers of NEIGRIHMS, or alternatively, if any relative of anofficer of NEIGRIHM S has financial interest/stake in the BIDDER's firm, the same shall be disclosed by theBIDDER atthetime offiling oftender.

Theterm 'relative'forthispurposewould beasdefinedinSection6oftheCompaniesAct,1956.

The BIDDER shallnot lend to or borrow any money fromor enter into any mon etary dealings ortransactions, directly or indirectly, with any employee of NEIGRIH MS.

4. Previous Transgression:-

The BIDDER declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last thr ee years immediately beforesigning of this Integrity Pact, with any other com pany in any country in respect of any corrupt practicesenvisaged hereunder o rwith any Public Sector Enterprise in India or any GovernmentDepartment in IndiathatcouldjustifyBIDDER'sexclusionfromthetenderprocess.

The BIDDER agrees that if it makes incorrect statement on this subject, BID DER can be disqualified fromthetenderprocessorthecontract, if already awarded .can beterminated for such reason.

5. EarnestMoney(SecurityDeposit):-

5.1 -Whilesubmittingcommercialbid,theBIDDERshalldepositanamount_____ (asspecifiedintheBid /Tender document) as Earnest Money/Security Deposit, with NEIGRIHMS, as specified in the Bid /Tenderdocument

The Earnest Money /Security Deposit shall be valid for a period of (as specifie d in the Bid /Tenderdocument) or the complete conclusion of the contractual obligations to the complete satisfaction of both theBIDDERandNEIGRIHMS,including warrantyperiod,whicheverislater.

In case of the successfulBIDDER a clause would also be incorporated in the Ar ticle pertaining toPerformance Bond /Security in the Purchase Contract that the provisions of Sanctions for Violation shall beapplicable for forfeiture ofPerformance Bond /Security in caseofadecisionby NEIGRIHMS to forfeit thesamewith outassigning anyreason forimposing sanctionforviolation ofthisPact.

No interest shall be payable by NEIGRIHMS to the BIDDER on Earnest Money / Security Deposit for theperiodofitscurrency.

6. Sanctionsfor Violations:-

Any breach of the aforesaid provisions by the BIDDER or any one employed by it or acting on its behalf(whether with or without the knowledge of the BID DER) shall entitle NEIGRIHMS to take all or any one of thefollowingactions, whe reverrequired:

- (i) Toimmediatelycallofftheprecontractnegotiationswithoutassigninganyreasonorgivinganycompensationtoth eBIDDER.However,theproceedingswiththeother BIDDER(s) wouldcontinue.
- (ii) The Earnest Money Deposit (in pre-contract stage) and / or Security Deposi t/Performance Bond (after thecontract is signed) shall stand forfeited either fully or partially, as decided by NEIGRIHMS and NEIGRIHMSshallnotbe required to oassign any reason therefore.
- (iii) Toimmediatelycancelthecontract,ifalready signed,withoutgivinganycompensationtotheBIDDER.

TorecoverallsumsalreadypaidbyNEIGRIHMS, and incase of an Indian BIDDER within terest thereonat 2% higher than the prevailing Prime Lending Rate of State Bank of India, while in case of a BIDDER from accountry other than India with interest thereon at 2% higher than the LIBOR. If any outstanding payment is duet of the BIDDER from NEIGRIHMS in connection with any other contract for any other stores, such outstanding payment could also be utilised to recover the aforesaids umand interest.

- (v) Toencashtheadvancebankguaranteeandperformancebond/warrantybond,iff urnishedbytheBIDDER,in ordertorecoverthe payments,alreadymade byNEIGRI HMS,along withinterest.
- (vi) To cancelallor any other Contracts with the BIDDER. The BIDDER shallbe li able to pay compensationfor any loss or damage to NEIGRIHMS resulting from such cancellation/rescission and NEIGRIHMS shall beentitledto deduct amo untsopayable from the money(s) due to the BIDDER.
- (vii) To debar the BIDDER from participating in future bidding processes of the Government of India for aminimumperiodoffiveyears, which may be further extended at the discretion of NEIGRIHMS.
- (viii) To recover all sums paid in violation of this Pact by BIDDER(s) to any mid dleman or agent or broker withaviewto securing the contract.
- (ix) In cases where irrevocable Letters of Credit have been received in respect of any contract signed byNEIGRIHMSwiththe BIDDER,thesameshallnotbeopened.
- (x) Forfeiture of Performance Bond in case of a decision by NEIGRIHMS to forfe it the same without assigninganyreason forimposing sanctionforviolation ofthi sPact.

NEIGRIHMS will be entitled to take all or any of the actions mentioned at para 6.1 (i) to (x) of this Pactalso on the Commission by the BIDDER or any one em ployed by it or acting on its behalf (whether with orwithout the knowledge of the BIDDER), of an offence as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860,or PreventionofCorruptionAct,1988,or anyother statuteenactedfor preventionofCorruption.

The decision of NEIGRIHMS to the effect that a breach of the provisions of this Pact has been committed by the BIDDER shall be final and conclusive on the BIDDER. However, the BIDDER can approach the Independent Monitor (s) appoint edforthe purposes of this Pact.

7. Fall Clause:-

TheBIDDERundertakesthatithasnotsupplied/isnotsupplyingsimilarproduct/syste msorsubsystemsat a price lower than that offered in the present bid in respect of any other Ministry / Department of theGovernment of India or PSU and if it is found at any stage that similar product/systems or subsystem wassupplied by the BIDDER to any other Ministry/Department of the Government of India or a PSU at a lowerprice, then that very price, with due allowance for elapsed time, will be applicable to the present case and the difference in the cost would be refunded by the BIDDER to NEIGRIHMS, if the contract has already beenconcluded.

8. Independent Monitors:

There shall be Independent Monitors (hereinafter referred to as Monitors) appointed by NEIGRIHMS forthisPactinconsultation withthe Central Vigilance Commission.

The task of the Monitors shall be to review independently and objectively, w hether and to what extent theparties comply with the obligation sunderthis Pact.

The Monitors shall not be subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and perform their functions neutrally and independently.

Both the parties accept that the Monitors have the right to access all the do cuments relating to the project/procurement, including minutes of meetings.

8.5 As soon as the Monitor notices, or has reason to believe, a violation of this Pact, he will so inform th eAuthority designated by NEIGRIHMS.

TheBIDDER(s)acceptsthattheMonitorhastherighttoaccesswithoutrestrictiontoall Projectdocumentation of NEIGRIHMS including that provided by the BIDDER. The BIDDER will also grant theMonitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to hisproject document ation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor shall be under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the BIDDER/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.

NEIGRIHMS will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetin gs among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could hav e an impact on the contractual relations between the parties. The parties will of fertothe Monitor the option to participate insuchmeetings.

The Monitor will submit a written report to the designated Authority of NEIGRI

HMS, within 8 to 10 weeksfrom the date of reference or intimation to him by N EIGRIHMS /BIDDER and, should the occasion arise, submitproposals for correcting problematic situations.

9. FacilitationofInvestigation:-

IncaseofanyallegationofviolationofanyprovisionsofthisPactorpaymentofcommission,NEIGRIHMSoritsagencie sshallbeentitledtoexamineallthedocumentsincludingtheBooksofAccountsoftheBIDDER andtheBIDDERshall providenecessaryinformationanddocumentsinEnglishandshallextendallpossiblehelpforthe purpose of such examination.

10.Lawand PlaceofJurisdiction:-

11.OtherLegal Actions:-

Theactionsstipulated in this Integrity Pactare without prejudice to any other legal action that may follow in accordance with the provisions of the extantlaw inforce relating to any civil or criminal proceedings.

12. Validity:

The validity of this Integrity Pact shall be from the date of its signing and exte nd upto 5 years or the complete execution of the contract to the satisfaction of both NEIGRIHMS and the BIDDER/Seller, includingwarranty period, whichever is later. In case BIDDER is unsuccessful, this Integrity Pact shall expire after six monthsfromthe date of the signing of the contract.

Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid, the remain der of this pact shallremainvalid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.

7. 8.2. The calculation of CMC Charges shall take into account the number of years of warranty and duration of CMC as specified while creating bid.

8.3.In the price evaluation, the system shall provide function to calculate the cost of each equipment by formula indicated below includingCMC and then show the inter-se-ranking of the bidders. The following are the variables

- (i) Number of years for which CMC required.
- (ii) Number of years of product warranty

The formula for calculating total cost including CMC charges shall be as under:

If 2 year warranty specified, n shall be 2 and if 5 year warranty specified, n shall be 5. A1,A2, A3, A4& A5shall depend on how many years CMC selected. For 3 year CMC, only A1,A2 and A3 factors are to be taken into account and A4 and A5 will not be applicable.

8.4.CMC charges offered for each subsequent year should be same or higher than preceding year.

8.5. The CMC charges shall be offered within range of 3 to 10% of cost of equipment.

9. Since CMC charges are to be paid only later for each year during CMC period, applicable performance guarantee amount after placement of contract shall be based on the cost of equipment excluding the cost of CMC Charges.

10.Performance bank guarantee applicable for CMC is to be submitted at start of the CMC and shall be applicable between 2.5% to 10% as specified in bid on total CMC Charges. The PBG submitted after award of contract shall be released only after new PBG for the CMC period is submitted and accepted by buyer/consignee after due verification. Bank guarantee for CMC is to remain valid till completion of CMC period plus one year. The bank guarantee for CMC shall be submitted to buyer directly. In case, seller fails to submit the PBG or does not provide services for the CMC contract after expiry of warranty period then PBG of equipment shall be forfeited.

11.In case of splitting of order quantity, equipment cost and CMC charges offered by L1 bidder shall be matched by higher quoting eligible bidders on one-to-one basis. The equipment cost and CMC charges (year to year) shall be matched individually.

12.The CMC Contract shall be an offline contract to be handled by buyer. The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user and scope of CMC will be as per para 1 above.

13.CMC Charges are inclusive of all the charges for Transportation, Lodging, Boarding, all insurances including third party insurance and all other incidental charges. The same shall include GST. The prices also include cost of spares and damaged parts. Purchaser does not have any liability, whatsoever, over and above the cost of CMC. It also includes for arranging hand tools & tackles, special tools etc. required to carry out the work.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
